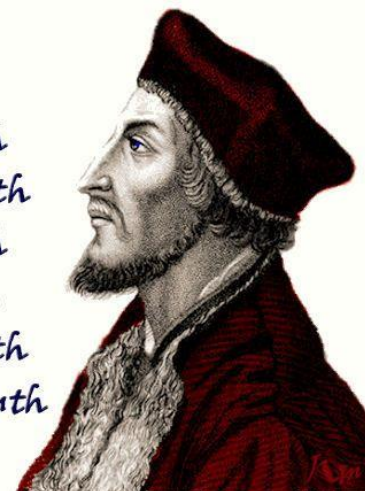

TODAY IS JOHN HUS SUNDAY

Today, we will have a special emphasis on John Hus who many consider to be the founder of the Moravian Church. On July 6, 1415, Hus was burned at the stake for his beliefs as he spoke against the abuse of the Roman Catholic Church in his day. Some of Hus' followers broke away for the Roma Catholic Church and began his one church called the Unitas Fratrum (Latin for "unity of brethren") which was the early Moravian Church. Part of our service will include the celebration of Holy Communion. Aso, today is the first Sunday of the month, and we will have our walk up offering for King Outreach Ministry.
