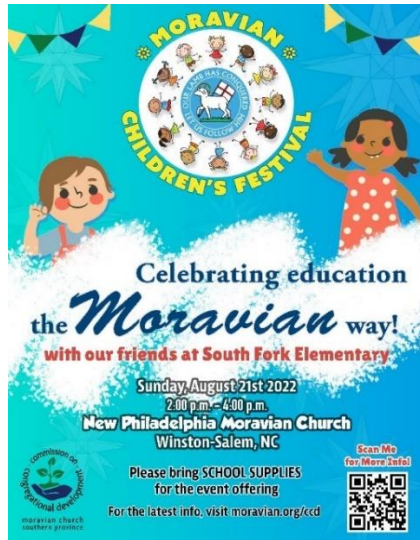

THE BOOK OF ROMANS

The book of Romans shares the basic gospel (the good news of Jesus) and teaches the following:

- God's plan of salvation for all humanity which has been provided through Jesus and his redemptive work on the cross.
- Our need for salvation and how to get right with God through faith.
- Salvation is only the beginning, and it is important for the believer to work out their Christian faith in practical ways.
